Jumpin' Jubilee

The Fairhope Committee On Public Art (COPA) is inviting artists to submit decorative designs now for its newest public art project, Jumpin' Jubilee, which will adorn the streets of Fairhope in 2011. The deadline for design proposals is April 24, 2010.

In the tradition of COPA's successful 2007 Party With the Pelicans/Art Takes Flight project, Jumpin' Jubilee will feature shrimp, crabs and flounders, all creatures found in Mobile Bay's mysterious jubilees.

Artists will be invited to paint and decorate one of 20 fiberglass flounders or 20 wooden crabs designed by found-object and special effects artist Bruce Larsen. The project also will include six limited-edition shrimp by Larsen.

The designs will be placed in a portfolio at the Eastern Shore Art Center and on the COPA website for selection by sponsors. Artists selected to paint a form will receive a stipend of \$200 plus 30% of the price brought at auction.

The jubilee creatures will be on public display throughout Fairhope for five months, from March until August 2011 and on exhibit at the Eastern Shore Art Center throughout the month of September 2011. COPA will host a reception and auction at the Fairhope Civic Center on October 1, 2011.

COPA, at a later date, will be inviting individuals, organizations and businesses to sponsor one of the sculptures.
